



Perfect Pie

n the 5th March we will be celebrating British Pie Week which has been running since 2007. Pie week is a great reason to celebrate a classic British tradition. We can't argue with the principle: a whole week eating pies! To tie in with St. David's Day, this fab recipe includes leeks, so why not give it a try?

Ingredients

Serves: 6

75g unsalted butter

2 leeks, sliced

1 onion, finely chopped

2 cloves garlic, crushed and chopped

1/2 glass white wine

2 tablespoons plain flour

200ml milk

250ml chicken stock

150ml double cream

50g grated mild Cheddar cheese

300g cooked ham cubed and fat discarded

300g cooked chicken

1 sheet puff pastry

1 egg, lightly beaten

Method

Prep:20min > Cook:40min > Ready in:1hr

Melt 25g of the butter in a frying pan over a low heat. Add the leeks and onion and cook and stir until soft, about 8 minutes. When softened, add the garlic and fry for a minute, then pour in the wine. Increase the heat and reduce the wine down.

- **2.** Once the quantity of liquid has halved, reduce the heat, add the rest of the butter and once melted, sprinkle in the flour. Keep stirring as it thickens.
- **3.** Gradually add the milk a few drops at a time, stirring constantly. Once all the milk has been added, continue to add the stock in the same way. Turn up the heat to allow to thicken. Finally add the cream and grated cheese, stir it in then remove from the heat once the cheese has melted and let the mixture cool.
- 4. Preheat the oven to 190 C / Gas 5.
- **5.** Add the chicken, gammon and cooled mixture to an ovenproof dish. Stir it all together. Cover with a puff pastry lid. Pierce with holes to let the steam out while cooking, and brush with a beaten egg to create a glaze.
- **6.** Bake in the preheated oven for 30 minutes or until the pastry is crisp and golden. Remove from the oven and serve immediately.

Tip:

You can prep the mixture to step 3 and pop the saucepan in the fridge until you are ready to do the final prep before serving, as it only takes 30 minutes it can be done in tandem with mash and veg prep.

Being in a temperate, maritime climate we are affected by the Gulf stream, Jet stream and by being close to a Continental climate too. This does cause farming to be weather dependent and too much of anything has a serious impact. Flooding of traditional flood plains and meadows brings a rich, fluvial deposit, but flooding on grass or sown arable land that hangs around for a while can make the ground sour or rot the seed.

Also, in cases of serious flooding, rocks and branches, fallen trees and rubbish are also left on the fields- costing much in time and effort to clear.

Snow (and cold temperatures)

can cause havoc, as it did several years ago when it came unexpectedly during spring lambing, as we have to carry feed out to any outlying sheep and cattle, make sure they have access to water and it makes every job take that little bit longer.

Of course, any hot, dry spells out of season will also cause problems - young shoots can shrivel.


So this is why farmers are always glued to any forecast they can find - searching for the one that will suit them best (and heaven help them if they're wrong!).



Hands That Do Dishes

it's no surprise that their hands can often become a little overlooked. Dry skin, overgrown cuticles and flaking nails can be the result of too much abuse and not enough love when it comes to hand care. With Mother's Day coming up on the 11th March why not give your Mum a home hand pamper?

Here's a step-by-step guide to a luxurious manicure that will leave your Mum feeling pampered and loved.

You will need:

- A file with varied coarseness.
- Apricot Oil or Shea Oil
- Cuticle stick
- Cotton pads
- Strengthening nail varnish
- 1. Buff, file and shape the nails to the desired result using a file. Removing ridges, smoothing and shining the nail will help the overall look become more polished, as well as helping the nails to look much healthier in the long-term.

- 2. Fill a small basin or bowl with warm water (not too hot!) and add five drops of Oil. Swirl the mixture a few times to distribute the oil and soak each hand for at least five minutes. The warm water will help to soften skin and enable you to push back cuticles later on, while the addition of the oil will help to nourish around the nail bed.
- 3. Once you've soaked your Mum's hands, dab a clean towel over the surface to remove any water or excess oil. Taking a cuticle stick, push back the cuticle area to reveal the full length of your nail and tidy up the edges; not only will this make your talons look neat and salon-worthy, but it aids growth and prevents flaking.
- 4. Add a drop of Oil to each individual nail and massage it into the surface, paying special attention to the cuticle area which can often become dry and neglected. (This is often the focus of professional manicures and the key to a salon look!) Take your time to really work the oil into the nail bed for maximum benefit.
- 5. For an additional pampering step, why not take a few drops of the Oil and massage into hands.

- 6. Use a cotton pad to wipe the surface of each individual nail to ensure it's completely clean (leftover oil or water can prevent nail polish from sticking effectively.) Apply a strengthening base coat to the naked nail, ensuring the nail is protected from any potential staining while simultaneously adding in some much needed support.
- 7. Finish with a colour of your Mum's choice and apply first with a straight line of polish down the centre of the nail. Add two more 'stripes' to either side to ensure the nail is fully covered, making sure you don't add any polish to the cuticle or skin - this can cause the colour to peel and flake after only a day or so. Apply a second thin coat, ensuring you don't overload the nail or add too much - this will only lengthen dry time and can cause peeling if the result is too thick.
- 8. To finish the look, add a topcoat to protect your colour and nail. Pay special attention to the end of the nail, 'sealing' the top by running a thin amount of topcoat along the edge. Again, this will help to prevent peeling and flaking of the colour especially if you're typing frequently. Ta-da, you're done!



Staffordshire Science

rom the 9th to the 18th March British Science Week will be taking down the place up and country. We thought we'd have a poke about in history for an interesting reminder of people from Staffordshire that have contributed so much to different fields of science. We've also got a top hit-list of science related places to take the kids!

Jessie MacWilliams (1917–1990).

A respected mathematician Jessie contributed to the field of coding theory. She moved to the United States in 1939 and studied at Johns Hopkins University. One year later she left Johns Hopkins for Harvard University. In 1955 she became a programmer and learned coding theory at Bell Labs where she spent most of her career.

William Astbury FRS (1898–1961)

A physicist and molecular biologist who worked with x-rays. His work on keratin provided the foundation for Linus Pauling's discovery of the alpha helix. He also studied the structure for DNA in 1937 and made the first step in the elucidation of its structure.

John L. Jinks (1929–1987)

A geneticist, educated at
Birmingham University
he remained there for the
majority of his career,
contributing to the

development of biometrical genetics, human behavioural genetics, and supervising a number of students who went on to make their own contributions.

Sir Oliver Lodge FRS (1851–1940)

A physicist and writer involved in the development of wireless telegraphy. A British physicist and writer involved in the development of, and holder of key patents for, radio.

Thomas Twyford (1849–1921)

Thomas was a pottery manufacturer in England. He invented the single piece, ceramic flush toilet. At the time of Twyford's death he was recognised as a leading pioneer in the application of principles of hygiene to sanitary appliances.

Thomas Wedgwood (1771–1805)

Son of Josiah Wedgwood, Thomas is the first person known to have thought of creating permanent pictures by capturing camera images on material coated with a light-sensitive chemical. practical experiments yielded only shadow image photograms that were not light-fast, but his conceptual breakthrough and partial success have led some historians to call him "the first photographer".

Tatenhill

A broadleaf tree bluebell woodland with mainly

mature woodland, grassland and scrub. Battlestead is sandwiched between two fledgling broadleaf planting schemes, the Bass Millennium Wood and East Hill Wood. The woods are linked by a network of rides and paths.



Eton Gateway

Stretton

The area is adjacent to the main A38. Known locally as Mike's Wood, it was planted on council land which was (or is) a balancing lake. It is really only used by dog walkers. This wood is owned by the National Forest



Sledge Wood

Repton

A lovely woodland with parking less than 500m away. This is a new woodland with beautiful views.

Sledge Wood is predominantly oak, with a smaller proportion of ash. There is a stream crossed by a bridge and a bench looking down towards Repton village with an information board at the entrance. Access is from Hartshorne Road or Robins Cross



Foxley Wood

Linton, Swadlincote

This is a broadleaf woodland less than 10 years old. Well worth a visit with free car parking at site. Originally known as Foxley Fields, Foxley Wood was planted over 1995 and 1996 with help from the local community and forms part of the National Forest. The trees have established well, and with the open areas seeded with wildflowers and superb views over the Trent Valley, this is a lovely spot for a visit - whether walking, on horseback or cycling.


