Eggcellent Easter!

Though today it is perhaps most celebrated as a time to gorge ourselves on various egg-shaped chocolate delicacies, Easter has, of course, a much deeper meaning behind it.

For Christians, Easter is the time to celebrate Christ's resurrection, proving that he was the son of God and their belief in the promise of eternal life. However, Easter did not always symbolize this; the meaning of Easter before the birth of Christianity was quite different than what is celebrated today. Originally, Easter was the feast of an Anglo-Saxon goddess known as Eostre or Eastre (pictured right, in "Ostara" - the High German version of her name - in 1884 by Johannes Gehrts).

It is thought that Eostre was the goddess of the dawn for Anglo-Saxons, and that the fourth month of the year, Eosturmonath, was named after her. Much theory and speculation surrounds her, as even in 725 when the Benedictine monk the Venerable Bede wrote his famous treatise 'De temporum ratione' ("On the Reckoning of Time"), he stated that the pagan rituals surrounding her had already died out.

Like many Christian holy days, the resurrection fell around the same time as the Saxon's feasting in honour of Eostre. So, in order to ease the conversion process, early

missionaries merged the two celebrations together to form the Easter as we know it today.

DECORATED EGGS

Anyone with children or grandchildren will probably be starting to think about either an Easter Egg Hunt, or Easter Egg decorating with the children and the simplest way to do that is to break out the acrylic paints!

More than 2,500 years ago, the ancient Persians were painting eggs for their New Year celebrations, which fell on the Spring Equinox. Sculptures on the walls of the ancient city of Persepolis show people carrying eggs for these occasions to the King.

DIFFERENT WORLD TRADITIONS:

EGG KNOCKING

In the US state of Louisiana, they've been knocking eggs together for around sixty years.

It's all part of a competition where you're knocked out if your egg cracks, leaving just one winner remaining.

SILENT FRENCH BELLS

Church Bells in France and parts of Belgium and the Netherlands stay silent for a number of days in the run up to Easter. The tradition says that the bells fly out of their steeples and fly to Rome, returning on Easter morning bringing both coloured eggs and hollow chocolate shaped like eggs and rabbits.

GERMANIC EASTER FIRES

Much like Bonfire Night in the UK, the northern and eastern parts of the Netherlands, as well as many parts of Northern Germany, light fires at sunset on Easter Day. This is a pre-Christian tradition, dating back to Saxon times when the people believed that the fire helped spring to become victorious over winter.

HOT CROSS BUNS

Traditionally associated with Good Friday, but now eaten throughout the year, these delicious spiced buns are served primarily in Britain, but also in the United States, Australia and New Zealand (where currants are often substituted for chocolate chips) and also in the Czech Republic, where it is a cake known as Mazanec.

Living to the Last

Families can remember their loved ones and celebrate the lives they lived at a special St Giles Hospice memorial garden in Whittington this spring.

Relatives and friends are being invited to dedicate a unique 'Celebrate Lives Lived' orange Gerbera peg, personalised with the name of their loved one, in return for a donation which will help to fund the work of St Giles supporting patients living with a terminal illness.

For 2021, St Giles has also set up a special virtual garden with the name of your loved one shown next to a Gerbera in an online display which can be viewed at any time. This will be particularly useful for people who are self-isolating or who do not wish to visit in person.

The gardens will create a colourful display of Gerbera pegs dedicated to the memory of loved ones, whether they have been cared for at St Giles Hospice or not, which will then be open to visitors throughout May, following current Government COVID-19 guidelines.

Lichfield police officer Gavin Farley (52) is supporting Celebrate Lives Lived this year in memory of his mother Sheila Watson, who died with leukaemia at St Giles Hospice last June at the age of 74.

Gavin said that although most people see going into a hospice as marking the end of life, for his mother St Giles was the beginning of a new phase of her life. "Despite her illness she enjoyed being there and made so many new friends," he said. "It wasn't just a place of sadness, it was a place of joy as well.

"Everyone is so caring and nothing is too much trouble. To mark VE Day, the hospice held its own celebrations and the staff did my mum's hair and makeup, which she really appreciated. Plus, when they found out that Monsters Inc. was her favourite film, they set it up on a laptop so that she

could watch it in her room. It's these little things that made such a massive difference.

"The staff at St Giles really went above and beyond what they had to do for their jobs – they were carers but became friends to us all, because they were as thoughtful and supportive to the families just as much as their patients.



"We'll definitely be supporting Celebrate Lives Lived, not only to thank St Giles for the way they looked after Mom, but as a way of celebrating her life and memory too. Despite the sadness of her passing, St Giles has so many good memories for us."



March “comes in like a lion and goes out like a lamb”, hopefully foretelling settled and warm weather for spring. The days are certainly longer (especially with the clocks going forward) and, somehow, there seems just more time to do things.

Which is just as well as there’s a lot more to do. Turnout time is here for our cows, especially if the weather is benevolent, but they have to pass the Btb test first.

The longer daylight hours kickstart the new grass growth and as it grows quickly, it is sequestering Carbon. Fertiliser will be applied soon to make sure it has enough nutrients to

help it grow, although our old ridge and furrow won’t get any as it is in a conservation scheme which forbids any improvement.

Dairy cattle will also be going out and making more and more milk as the nutrition in the grass improves. This spring flush does cause price to drop as there is plenty of milk available and there is a new dairy code of conduct being put into legislation, to set minimum standards of business practise- milk buyers have previously been able to change terms and introduce price cuts without negotiation. You might see secretive Bullfinches, with their exquisite deep red breast,

sitting and singing in shrubs or fruit trees and brimstone butterflies with their sulphur yellow wings around the alder trees, after over wintering in ivy. The alder trees themselves will be flowering before the leaves appear.

March, what a magnificent abundant month!

A Wild Ride

With many of the lockdown restrictions purported to be easing over the coming months one of the sectors most relieved will be Zoos and Wildlife Parks, who will be able to reopen from 12th April all going well.

Zoos and Wildlife Parks have borne a great burden during the pandemic, with visitor numbers eliminated and ticket sales at next to nil, much of the revenue relied on to feed the animals and pay for the specialist zoologists and staff that care for them has all but disappeared.

Our two nearest zoos at Twycross and Drayton Manor will need much help from the public if they are to continue to look after their animals and facilities.

The priciest animals...

We're not talking about your average house cat or parakeet here, if you've ever taken a pet to the vet for something extraordinary you'll appreciate how much investment of love and money it takes to keep animals, so imagine what the zoos are facing!

In general, the bigger the animal the more expensive. If we are talking about every single aspect, the most expensive would be the giant panda. China makes zoos pay millions per year for their leased pandas, they eat a ton of bamboo and they require very specific enclosures.

One that might surprise you are the smaller species of bat that live in giant flocks. Not only do they eat a lot, but they produce so much poop and ammonia its a 24/7 job to keep enclosures clean.

In the wild a big cat can eat up to 45kg (7st) of meat and bone in one sitting. This is due to the fact that they're not the best hunters and may not catch anything else for a number of days. In captivity with a sedentary lifestyle, you would expect a large cat to eat between 4kg - 8kg five times per week. That's quite a shopping bill!

There are certain species of Asian langurs that are very picky eaters, so it can become costly to buy all of the special leaves they need to eat.

Hippos are known for being expensive. Not because they are very difficult animals to keep happy, not at all. Its the fact they poop so incredibly much that their bassins usually look like chocolate milk. Thats why the filters have to be on at all times and we aren't talking about small aquarium filters, we are talking about building sized filters.

...so in terms of upkeep, aside from food, who knew poop was such a costly factor!

In anticipation of the lifting of restrictions, why not plan your visit for after the 12th April. As always, please do keep up-to-date with all Government guidelines and restrictions in place, as ever, things can change fast and we must all do our bit!

Thai New Year

The original Thai New Year starts on April 13th and finishes on April 15th. Called Songkran it was the official New Year until 1888, when it was switched to a fixed date of 1 April. Then in 1940, this date was shifted to 1 January in line with western countries. Following this the traditional Thai New Year Songkran was transformed into a national holiday. A much loved festival in the Thai calendar, many Thai people, using any excuse for a party, even extend the celebrations to six whole days in the northern city of Chiang Mai.

The Thai New Year, like the

Chinese New Year, is assigned an animal and this year is also the year of the Ox for the Thai people.

Each year the festival's figurehead, the holy child Lady Songkran is assigned different symbols and colours for the procession, depending on what day the festival falls on. This year the festival falls on a Tuesday, signified by the colour pink and lotus flowers, in her right hand she will hold a trident and in her left hand a bow.

The most common sight around Thai New Year is water fights, and during this time you will see people roaming the

streets with buckets and water pistols, soaking everyone in sight - April is the hottest month in Thailand, after all!

Build a Mini Wildlife Pond

We've had a few days where it certainly feels like spring is springing and now is the time of year to consider supporting wildlife in your garden. Many animals will be looking for suitable places to call home and rear their young over the coming months. Building a mini-pond will not only support all kinds of different aquatic life and insects, but will provide drinking water for small mammals and birds too! Here's how to build one...

You will need...

- a watertight container such as an upcycled bucket or plastic tub
- old bricks, rock and pebbles
- some pond plants
- a spade

What you need to do...

1 Choose a spot. Your pond will need light, but not full sunlight all day. You can dig a hole and sink your container, or just have it sitting on top of the ground.

2 If the container isn't watertight, e.g. An old plant pot, then add a piece of pond liner.

3 Add a layer of gravel and rocks.

4 Fill your pond with rainwater (tap water contains additives that

are good for humans but not safe for small wildlife).

5 Start planting, you only need two or three plants. When choosing your pond plants, consider choosing some that stick out of the water and some that live under the surface that can provide cover from predators.

6 Now watch and wait! Wildlife will come to your mini-pond of its own accord! Why not keep a nature journal of creatures that you spot around the pond?



One vertical growing plant that reaches out of the water e.g. flowering rush

Use logs or stones to create a range of depths and a slope for creatures to climb in and out

One submerged plant e.g. hornwort or spiked water milfoil



Caring for Your Pet's Teeth by Scarsdale Vets

The nursing team at Scarsdale Vets offer you some tips on keeping your pet's teeth in good condition.

1. Feed them an appropriate diet. This may sound silly, but if we all ate sweets all day we would have bad teeth too! Rabbits and herbivores need grass or hay to be 90% of their diet to allow their teeth to wear. Dogs and cats need dry food to crunch on and not just wet food. Dental treats are high in sugar and fat so should be used sparingly.

2. Start them young. Most dogs and a lot of cats will tolerate brushing their teeth if you start them as puppies or kittens. Starting with an older dog will be a hassle so as soon as you get your dog or cat, start putting your fingers around their mouth so they get used to it.

3. If you brush, do it every day – tartar can build up within 48 hours so daily cleaning is a necessity if you want to prevent dental disease.

4. Watch them eat – early signs of dental disease or mouth pain are subtle. Chewing on

one side, reluctance to eat or a change in what they want to eat can indicate that everything isn't alright in their mouth.

5. Not all dry foods are equal. Dental diets have larger kibbles and a more fibrous consistency which is better at keeping teeth clean.

6. Use an animal toothbrush and toothpaste. Minty fresh breath may not appeal to your pet, but chicken flavour toothpaste can help them tolerate brushing.

7. Other products available include additives to the water or food – your Veterinary Nurse will be able to advise you on what is most suitable for your pet

8. Get them checked: A vet or a nurse should check your pet's teeth every year. It should be done with their vaccinations and early signs can be spotted and managed before they become a problem

9. Let them chew. Rabbits can gnaw on some sticks and branches and there are various chews designed for cats and dogs. These not only help clean their teeth, but provide them with mental stimulation when you are not there. (as vets we would suggest avoiding meat bones as we see a lot of problems with these)

10. Check they have lost all their deciduous (baby) teeth by 8 months. If they remain they can push the adult teeth out of alignment and this can lead to additional tartar build up.

11. Remember how important their teeth are. Dental disease can lead to many other health problems, including liver and kidney problems. Looking after them will help your pet to live a longer happier life.


