nd of the year fast approaching and dark nights, short days are now the norm!

While livestock. such as housed cattle and dairy cows can be dealt with when inside, the livestock still out in the fields can only properly be checked over during daylight and energy bills begin to rise at this time.

Lighting in sheds must be safe so as not to injure any animal (or person) and is obviously used much more. Headlights on machinery are also used much more and anyone working in the vicinity really ought to be wearing hi-viz.

Some farmers will be carrying out field work, particularly on later harvested crop fields where such as maize or field beans had grown.

For those lambing early, then feeding ewes may well be part of the routine and some will be coming in later on as they get closer to giving birth.

Hedge laying will begin as the sap stops rising- essential for keeping animals where they are safe and logs can be retrieved for later use on the fire. Elsewhere in the country where stone walls are the order of the day, these can also be repaired.

If we've had plenty of rain previously, our two old hay meadows may get a soaking overflow from from the boundary brooks. Although this tends to happen mainly during later winter months, it's not unknown for the brook to be out in the morning and gone by lunchtime.

Although we no longer make hav from them. l can remember tedding (turning the hay) and rowing up after hubby had mown the grass (he suffered badly from hay fever) and then helping to load and bring in the small bales, approximately 100 bales to the acre (7 rows high and 30 bales on each layer on each bale trailer) and having to stack them under the barn (1200 in a good year from the larger of the two meadows). Phew!

Now, these are grazed, providing a good bite for our animals. The rig and furrow is still noticeable in them.

Our Silver birch tree, the 'lady of the woods', is a beautiful tree, branches sweeping in the winds and fronds of leaves whipping round and the leaves get everywhere- piles blown into every corner, providing cover for little animals go hide in as they search for food.

Our cattle will come in now, if they haven't already and, after a few weeks inside, they will be wormed for fluke- a parasite that affects the liver and can be serious. It is found on wet pasture and water snails are part of its life cycle. Needless to say the cattle are not keen as it's usually administered by an injection or a drench.

Ted will be working hard, moving sheep around their grazing and helping to fetch lambs in for weighing . It's important he is also kept in fine fettle too and a nutritious diet means he has the energy, if not the inclination, to work. A few days off for him over Christmas though, I think and a merry Christmas to you too, from us at the farm

Left-over Choc Bites

ust when you think you've eaten all the chocolate you possibly can, along comes a second wind! By this point though, it's likely that it's only 'randoms' left in the chocolate tin! Why not make this fun snack to keep your chocolate cravings at bay and use up the last of the Christmas treats. Every bite is an adventure!



Choc Bites

Ingredients

250g Dark chocolate 200g Milk chocolate 200g Butter 150g Golden syrup 100g Digestive biscuits 75g Mini marshmallows 250g left over chocolates

Method

Line an 8ⁿ square tin with baking paper. Grease the tin first with a little butter to help the paper stick to it.

Chop up your leftover chocolates into chunks and bash up your biscuits into pieces.

Put the butter, golden syrup, dark chocolate and milk chocolate in a pan and melt together on a low heat, stirring together as it melts.

Once it's fully melted and combined, take the pan off the heat.

Prepare a bowl with the broken up biscuits, marshmallows and about two thirds of the chopped up chocolates (reserve the rest for decorating the top).

Stir in the biscuits & marshmallows.

Pour about two thirds of the chocolate mixture into the bowl of biscuits etc. and stir to fully coat the fillings with chocolate.

Pour the whole lot into the

lined tin, smooth down then add the remaining chocolate mixture to fill in any gaps.

Add the remaining left over chocolate chunks to the top to decorate.

Put in the fridge overnight, or for 3-4 hours to set.

To serve, remove from the tin and chop into slices using a sharp knife.

If you store the chock bites in an airtight container it can be kept for 1 - 2 weeks, and up to 3 weeks in the fridge. It is best kept in the fridge.

s if there isn't enough fizz floating around over the Christmas season... Did you know that December 31st is National Champagne Day? No? Well neither did we... so you can imagine our delight! Instead of drinking Champagne, you could make a champagne cocktail that will be perfect for New Year's Eve. For instance, Mimosa is a classic Champagne cocktail and here we have two suitably festive flavours for you to try!

Mirabelle Mimosa (Serves 1)

Ice 20ml Plum Puree 5ml Pernod 130ml chilled Champagne 2 red plum slices



Directions

Fill a pint glass with ice. Add the Plum Puree, Pernod and Champagne and stir gently. Strain into a chilled flute and garnish with the plum slices.

Pepermint Fizz (Serves 6)

25g melted chocolate 3 candy canes, crushed 150ml peppermint schnapps, divided between 6 glasses 1 bottle champagne 6 candy canes, whole

Directions

Pour melted chocolate onto a small plate. Pour crushed candy canes onto a separate plate. Dip rims of champagne flutes first in chocolate, then in crushed candy canes to coat.


